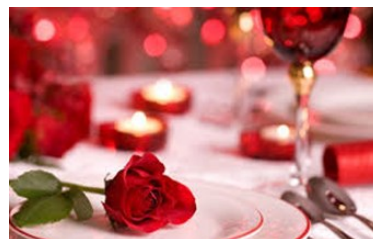
World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life
