PENTECOST SUNDAY



Pentecost marks one of the most important feasts in the Church's liturgical year. Occurring fifty days after Easter Sunday, Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary, empowering them, as Jesus promised He would, to preach the gospel to the whole world (Acts 2; see Acts 1:4-8). Often called the "birthday of the Church," this day is a wondrous reminder of how Jesus fully equips His Church to carry out her Great Commission to "make disciples all nations" (Matt. 28:18-20; see Isa. 49:6, 22).

DOMINGO DE PENTECOSTÉS



Pentecostés marca una de las fiestas más importantes del año litúrgico de la Iglesia. Cincuenta días después del Domingo de Pascua, Pentecostés conmemora la venida del Espíritu Santo sobre los apóstoles y la Santísima Virgen María, capacitándolos, como Jesús prometió, para predicar el evangelio a todo el mundo (Hechos 2; véase Hechos 1:4-8). Conocido a menudo como el «cumpleaños de la Iglesia», este día es un maravilloso recordatorio de cómo Jesús capacita plenamente a su Iglesia para llevar a cabo su Gran Comisión de «hacer discípulos a todas las naciones» (Mt. 28:18-20; véase Is. 49:6, 22).
