ST. BRIDGET OF SWEDEN

JULY 23



Saint Bridget of Sweden (c. 1303–1373), also known as Birgitta of Sweden, is one of the few Roman Catholic saints of Scandinavia. Sometimes referred to as the "Mystic of the North," Bridget was a wealthy, pious woman who experienced religious visions from her early childhood. After her husband died, she founded a religious order, the Brigittines, and worked to heal a breach in the church that had resulted in the removal of the papacy to Avignon, France. In 1999 Pope John Paul II named her one of the patron saints of Europe, along with St. Therese Benedicta of the Cross and St. Catherine of Siena, two other holy women who devoted their careers to ending religious and political strife in Europe.

SANTA BRÍGIDA DE SUECIA 23 DE JULIO



Santa Brígida de Suecia (c. 1303–1373), también conocida como Brígida de Suecia, es una de las pocas santas católicas romanas de Escandinavia. A veces llamada la "Mística del Norte", Brígida era una mujer adinerada y piadosa que experimentó visiones religiosas desde su primera infancia. Después de que su esposo murió, fundó una orden religiosa, las Brigittinas, y trabajó para sanar una brecha en la iglesia que había resultado en el traslado del papado a Aviñón, Francia. En 1999, el Papa Juan Pablo II la nombró una de las santas patronas de Europa, junto con Santa Teresa Benedicta de la Cruz y Santa Catalina de Siena, otras dos santas mujeres que dedicaron sus carreras a poner fin a los conflictos religiosos y políticos en Europa.
