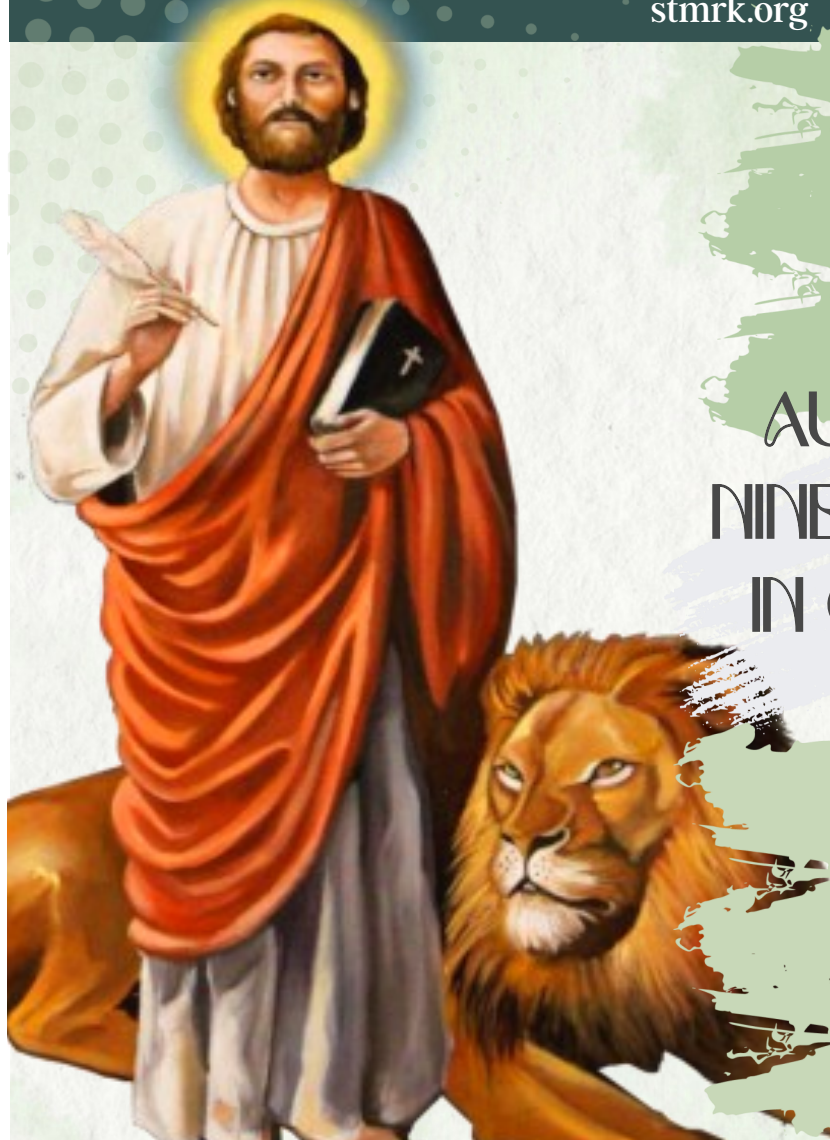

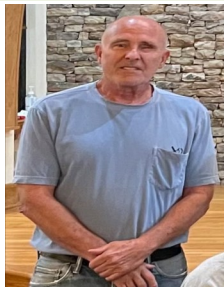

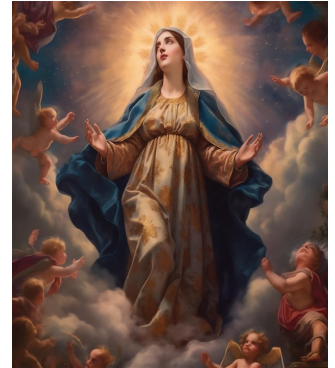

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is one of the most beautiful and ancient beliefs of the Catholic Church. It teaches that Mary, the Mother of Jesus, was taken body and soul into Heaven at the end of her earthly life.

The Church believes that because of Mary's sinless life and her unique role in salvation history, God did not allow her body to see decay. Instead, He assumed her—body and soul—into heavenly glory, where she reigns as Queen of Heaven.

This truth was dogmatically defined by Pope Pius XII in 1950, but it has been believed by Christians since the early centuries Of the Church.

Mary's Assumption is a sign of hope for all believers. It shows us:

The destiny of those who follow Christ—to share in His resurrection.

That death is not the end, but a passage to eternal life.

Mary's powerful role as our intercessor and mother in Heaven.

FIESTA DE LA ASUNCIÓN DE LA SANTÍSIMA VIRGEN MARÍA AL CIELO 15 DE AGOSTO



La Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María es una de las creencias más hermosas y antiguas de la Iglesia Católica. Enseña que María, la Madre de Jesús, fue llevada en cuerpo y alma al Cielo al final de su vida terrenal.

La Iglesia cree que, debido a la vida sin pecado de María y su papel único en la historia de la salvación, Dios no permitió que su cuerpo viera la corrupción. En cambio, la asumió, en cuerpo y alma, a la gloria celestial, donde reina como Reina del Cielo.

Esta verdad fue definida dogmáticamente por el Papa Pío XII en 1950, pero ha sido creída por los cristianos desde los primeros siglos de la Iglesia.

La Asunción de María es un signo de esperanza para todos los creyentes. Nos muestra:

El destino de quienes siguen a Cristo: participar en su resurrección.

Que la muerte no es el final, sino un paso a la vida eterna.

El poderoso papel de María como nuestra intercesora y madre en el Cielo.
