SAINT PETER CHRYSOLOGUS

JULY 30



St. Peter Chrysologus, Bishop and Doctor of the Church, was born in Imola, Italy in 380, St. Peter was baptized, educated, and ordained a deacon by Cornelius, Bishop of Imola. St. Peter merited being called "Chrysologus" (golden-worded) from his exceptional oratorical eloquence. In 433, Pope Sixtus III consecrated him bishop of Ravenna. He practiced many corporal and spiritual works of mercy, and ruled his flock with utmost diligence and care. He rooted out the last vestiges of paganism and other abuses that had sprouted among his people. He also counseled the heretic Eutyches (who had asked for his support) to avoid causing division but to learn from the other heretics who were crushed when they hurled themselves against the Rock of Peter. He died at Imola, Italy in 450 and in 1729 was made a Doctor of the Church, largely as a result of his simple, practical, and clear sermons which have come down to us, nearly all dealing with Gospel subjects.

JSAN PEDRO CRISÓLOGO

30 DE JULIO



San Pedro Crisólogo, obispo y doctor de la Iglesia, nació en Imola, Italia, en 380. Fue bautizado, educado y ordenado diácono por Cornelio, obispo de Imola. San Pedro merecía ser llamado "Crisólogo" (palabras de oro) por su excepcional elocuencia oratoria. En 433, el papa Sixto III lo consagró obispo de Rávena. Practicó muchas obras de misericordia corporales y espirituales, y gobernó su rebaño con la mayor diligencia y cuidado. Desarraigó los últimos vestigios del paganismo y otros abusos que habían brotado entre su pueblo. También aconsejó al hereje Eutiques (que había pedido su apoyo) que evitara causar división, pero que aprendiera de los otros herejes que fueron aplastados cuando se lanzaron contra la Roca de Pedro. Murió en Imola, Italia, en 450 y en 1729 fue nombrado Doctor de la Iglesia, en gran parte como resultado de sus sermones sencillos, prácticos y claros que han llegado hasta nosotros, casi todos tratando temas del Evangelio.
