SAINT THERESE OF THE CHILD JESUS OCTOBER 1



Thérèse of Lisieux (born Marie Françoise-Thérèse Martin; 2 January 1873 – 30 September 1897), in religion Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face, was a French Discalced Carmelite who is widely venerated in modern times. She is popularly known in English as the Little Flower of Jesus, or simply the Little Flower.

Therese has been a highly influential model of sanctity for Catholics and for others because of the simplicity and practicality of her approach to the spiritual life. She is one of the most popular saints in the history of the church, although she was obscure during her lifetime. Pope Pius X called her "the greatest saint of modern times".

SANTA TERESA DEL NIÑO JESÚS 1 DE OCTUBRE



Teresa de Lisieux (nacida Marie Françoise-Thérèse Martin; 2 de enero de 1873 - 30 de septiembre de 1897), Teresa del Niño Jesús y de la Santa Faz, fue una carmelita descalza francesa muy venerada en la actualidad. Se la conoce popularmente como la Pequeña Flor de Jesús, o simplemente la Pequeña Flor.

Teresa ha sido un modelo de santidad muy influyente para los católicos y para otros debido a la sencillez y practicidad de su enfoque de la vida espiritual. Es una de las santas más populares de la historia de la Iglesia, aunque fue desconocida durante su vida. El Papa Pío X la llamó «la santa más grande de los tiempos modernos».
