The Rosary, by meditating on the mysteries of Christ's life through Mary's eyes, continues to be a lifeline of grace and a weapon of spiritual protection for Christians throughout the world.

Nuestra Señora del Rosario se honra el 7 de octubre, festividad establecida para conmemorar la victoria de la flota cristiana en la Batalla de Lepanto en 1571, un triunfo atribuido al poder del Rosario. Sin embargo, la devoción a María a través del Rosario es muy anterior a ese momento histórico. La tradición sostiene que Santo Domingo recibió el Rosario de la Santísima Virgen en el siglo XIII como un medio para promover la oración y la conversión. A lo largo de los siglos, innumerables santos y papas han animado a los fieles a adoptar esta devoción, reconociendo su poder para traer paz, fortalecer a las familias y profundizar la fe. El Rosario, al meditar sobre los misterios de la vida de Cristo a través de la mirada de María, sigue siendo un salvavidas de gracia y un arma de protección espiritual para los cristianos de todo el mundo.
